Strike Threat Closes Schools

Fewtucket, R. I., Dec. 9.—(AP)—Public schools in this city of more than 75,000 were ordered closed today following a strike threat for higher wages by seventy per cent of the system's 430 teachers.

School Committee Chairman Grover C. Haberlin ordered all principals and clerks to stay away from the schools and said that only janitors would be allowed in the buildings.

Approximately 6,000 pupils, affected about 9,000 pupils, resulted from the order to "shut the schools."

Teachers' Alliance (AFL) pay raise demands.

The Alliance is seeking pay scales ranging from an 1,800 minimum to \$4,000 a year, including as much as \$500 to some teachers.

Last Wednesday, approximately 250 teachers approved a strike vote, but the vote, though the vote, is only advisory. The school committee is expected to meet today to negotiate with the teachers.

However, Haberlin replied that he would not call any school committee meeting to negotiate with the teachers until the strike vote is held over the committee's head.

Opposes Teachers' Strike

In a formal statement, the executive committee of the Rhode Island Federation of Teachers opposed the teachers' strike, but criticized local school conditions which cause teachers to strike and threaten to walk out.

The federation, with an enrollment of 1,000 public school teachers, called upon the State Department of Education for "positive action" in helping to adjust teachers' salaries.

Teachers don't want to strike, but striking is being forced upon them, William P. Blanton, Jr., federation president, said.

Four Violent State Deaths

Two caused by gunshot wounds; others in traffic accidents

Four persons died violently in Connecticut over the week-end, two of them in traffic accidents and two others deaths were caused by gunshot wounds, one being termed by police a murder, the other a suicide.

Edna Dickerson, 22-year old Hartford Negro, was being held on a charge of murder, said Hartford County Detective Joseph P. Mitchell in connection with the slaying by gunshot Saturday afternoon of Lester Mason, 35, also a Negro, in the Hartford North Mead street area.

Questioned 14 Hours

Mason's body, a gunshot wound in the chest and knife cuts on the left wrist, was found Saturday afternoon on the sidewalk near Dickerson and two other Negroes were arrested shortly afterwards on a breach of the peace charge.

Mitchell said the murder charge was lodged against Dickerson after 14 hours of questioning. The other two men were released, he said.

The slaying, Mitchell said, was described by police as a "cold-blooded" killing.

Mrs. Helen Bottwell, 27, of West Hartford, mother of two children, died Sunday at St. Francis hospital, Hartford, of wounds described by police as self-inflicted.

Mrs. Bottwell police said, had been in the dependent since the death of her husband following his return to the hospital, Hartford, of wounds from having received a notice to vacate her apartment.
