The rating of airline transport pilot has been added to the list of Civil Aeronautics Administration ratings for which veterans may receive flight pay under the GI Bill, according to an announcement from the Hartford Regional Office of the Veterans Administration.

Flight courses under this law previously were limited by VA to those leading to CAA's private pilot, commercial pilot, flight instructor, instrument rating and multi-engine rating.

VA does not pay for flight training unless the course leads directly to a CAA rating. Like all flight training under the GI Bill, flight training under this law must be handled by contract between VA and flight training schools.
