\$9,000 Award In Legal Suit

Settlement Reached in Action That Followed Death of Woman

A settlement for \$9,000 was reached in the Superior Court yesterday in a suit asking \$35,000, that had been in progress for several days before Judge John A. Cornell and a jury.

The suit was brought by Frank Warden against the Connecticut Light and Power Company as a result of a fire in Lyme on September 22, 1945 at the Edward Lyman Hill farm, Mr. Warden was caretaker of the farm, and his wife, who was formerly Miss Gertrude Lappin of Edroize street, this town, died some time after a result of a cancer. The cancer was the result of an electric shock, it was claimed. The fire was caused by a fallen wire which struck a barn, 50 tons of hay, 18 cows and a calf.
