The Healthy Four

At the Bowers bloc on the Board of Directors consists of those members who claim to be intelligent and courageous and eager for economy in the interests of all the people, it would have to follow that the other four members of the Board are unintelligent, lacking in courage, indifferent to economy, and not concerned with the welfare of Manchester.

Before the Keeney Street School issue, only one of them, perhaps, had been guilty of any crime in the eyes of the Bowers bloc. He had originally run for office under one of those vaillant slogans Mr. Bowers so frequently offers the public—that time, he believes, was the "Unbiased." But after coming into office on this slogan, he found that it was being assumed that his vote was automatically available for any number of arbitrary decisions, and he decided to reclaim his own independence of opinion and vote.

Here, we think, the attitude of the four was clearly explained by one of the four at the Holtshire School meeting. He said, truthfully enough, that economy was not the issue—that all members of the Board would have been most willing to entertain any suggestion for economy seriously made during the normal consideration of the project. But there was no such move on the part of the Bowers bloc. It did not go to the people and recommend that the Keeney Street School plans and appropriation be turned down, so that a new start could be made.

The minority of four on the Board did not join in this last minute plot. Because they refused, the inference is that they were not so keen and intelligent as the Bowers bloc, not so much concerned with the taxpayer's dollar, not so fit for public office.
