Kentucky Reigns as No. 1 College Basketball Powerhouse

Two Cage Conferences Conclude Seasons in Tie; NCAA Starts

New York, March 9 (AP)—With the exception of the Southeastern Conference and Ivy League which wound up in a dead heat, all the conference basketball seasons were over today and the NCAA post-season tournament was ready to get down to the serious business of selecting its participants.

Games were scheduled at four sites tonight—Fort Wayne, Nashville, Peoria, Ill., and Corvallis, Ore. The game at the Southeastern Conference championship between Kentucky, the only major undefeated team in the nation, and Louisiana State.

The Wildcats, No. 1 in the weekly Associated Press poll, are rated the favorites to crash through to one of the final spots. Indiana, the Big Ten champion and defending NCAA titleholder, is the other choice for the win at Kansas City on March 20.

But the other schools vying for spots in the region's finals will have their own troubles tonight.

Wildcats Gain Big Edge Over the Runners; Connecticut Receives More Than 10 Points

New York, March 9 (AP)—Lincoln Kentigley entered his Southeastern Conference play-off with eighth ranked Louisiana State today as the No. 1 college basketball power in the nation.

THE WILDCATS, favored to defeat the Tigers for an NCAA Tournament berth, were the first choice of 42 of the 95 sports writers and spectators who voted in the Associated Press poll. It marked the ninth time in the past 13 weeks Kentucky has headed the list.
