**Part of the Verdict**

The resignation of Roy Coch tendered and accepted two hours before it would have been forced by vote of the McCarthy committee, is the first tangible verdict reached as a result of the Army-McCarthy hearings. It is in the first instance, the resignation of Senator McCarthy, the Michigan Republican who plays the McCarthy case close to the White House. It was his stand and his prospective vote which made the Coch discharge inevitable. But even those pro-McCarthy Senators, Mundt and Dickson, were not fighting very hard to save Coch. It turned out, after all, with all the mass of testimony, that the conduct of Coch in the Schine case had been something unusual and improper indeed.

Yet, if that was the peg on which his retirement from public service to McCarthy has been hung, it still was not the basic reason. Coch has been retired because of what he himself said and because of the nature of the man he served. He himself was the perfect servant of the machine. It is a question in all respects except one. He was canny, clever, ruthless, and cruel. His fault, from the legislative point of view, was that he allowed his nose to go to his head, as if he were a young man who could spin the whole globe as he pleased. But his goal is not merely a result of his own fault as an inquisitor. It is also the result of the fact that he was perfectly the symbol of the technique and intent of the man he served.

**The Old Rescue The Old**

India, modernly, has enough rice. And that development, if we know nothing else about it, would immediately lead to the conclusion that here was an inspiring example of American agricultural "know-how", plus modern agricultural equipment, entering a backward, feudal country and accomplishing a common sense miracle. And there are indeed other phases of Indian agriculture where American methods are being used. But the method of planting and tilling which the Indians have adopted a few years of the Japanese method, went for them in a big way because they produced record yields. The Japanese method involved planting the rice in rows instead of better-skitter, trans-planting the young plants to a greater distance from one another, and supporting the heads of the plants in the monsoon season by tying them to the ground. The Japanese method required no change in the traditional ancient tool of the Indian peasant. It was just a different way of using the same tool. The simplest discovery in the whole business was that one rice plant will produce more actual grain than the five rice plants the Indians used to put in the same space.
