Moment of Sovereignty

Tomorrow, the people of America exercise the privilege which is the foundation of their way of life.

In the voting booth, each individual American is king and sovereign.

This is the periodically scheduled day on which individual Americans themselves take direct control of their own fortunes.

The day before, and the day after, this control is delegated to some one else.

But in the voting booth, the individual American must function for himself. He cannot turn his task over to some one else.

What happens in the voting booth is his own business. Furthermore, it is primarily an expression of himself.

We believe the voters of America have an necessary knowledge, encompassing the highest opportunities open to them. We do not believe they make very many mistakes.

In their ultimate selection, in their ultimate selection, if it is in so, it is only because individual Americans do regard the voting function as a sacred trust. If it is in so, it is only because individual Americans really reach deep inside themselves for an ounce of discrimination and choice which lies beyond superficialities, campaign appeals, or the apparent atmosphere of the political season.

It is because this final decision lies, with so many voters, in some deep inner standard of judgment, that the pollsters and prognosticators can so often be proved wrong. It is because this final decision does so often come from the finest core of feeling and choice within the individual voter that the result is, so very often, a result which has inner rightness, and resultant strength and benefit for the nation.

To this high function, the voters of America address themselves tomorrow. There is in this moment, inside the voting machine, when the individual American is master of everything, with all the responsibility that implies, with all the demands upon his conscience that implies.

When the voter responds to this deep, significant challenge, his country never needs to fear. The decision, whatever it is, will be right.

Shrugging It Off?

Significantly, every top diplomat connected with the recent Paris agreements has now stated that the result of these agreements must be to pave the way for the reunification of Germany.

This theory was last stated by President Eisenhower and Chancellor Adenauer in their joint communique at Washington Thursday.

But this agreement does not solve the problem. The question still is one of when and how Germany shall be reunified.

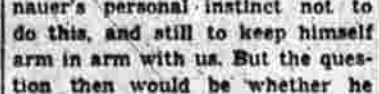
United States diplomacy hopes it can be accomplished by negotiation of Britain, France, the United States and West Germany with Soviet Russia. And that negotiations toward the unification of Germany should be carried on by these powers was one of the important statements of the Washington communique.

But we, although we want to be on the negotiations for the reunification of Germany, are in no hurry about it. Neither is Adenauer. But France is in something of a hurry, and Britain, in a showdown, is probably closer to France than to us.

Here there arises something of an impossible dilemma, which Adenauer apparently is beginning to face in mind. We do not want to negotiate until the Paris agreements have been ratified. But, at

Your Dental Health

Pregnancy and Dental Disease

Following is a series of articles on "Your Dental Health" presented by The Herald in cooperation with the Manchester Dental Society. Today, pregnancy and dental disease.

Again and again, dentists must debunk the old wives' tale that a tooth is lost for each child born.

The legend possibly grew during the early days when it was believed harmful for any work to be done on the mouth during pregnancy. As a result, teeth were neglected for the nine months.

This often meant that at least one tooth decayed so badly that it had to be extracted.

Today, dentists and physicians agree. It is not only safe for an expectant mother to visit the family dentist, but essential.

Contrary to the popular legend, calcium salts are not drained from the mother's teeth during pregnancy. Nor is the saliva in her mouth unusually acid.

Clinical studies also indicate that the dental decay rate during this period is normal. Thus, pregnancy in itself is not a cause of dental disease.

If dental decay increases during pregnancy, it is probably the result of increased and frequent consumption of sweets, poor mouth

hygiene and neglecting to have regular dental examinations.

For these reasons, many dentists advise pregnant women to receive dental care, including monthly prophylaxis at intervals of every three or four months. And mothers are instructed to brush their teeth carefully after eating.

Many dentists believe that there can be increased gum disease during pregnancy. Regardless of the cause, however, it is universally agreed that the best protection against gum disorders in pregnancy is good oral hygiene and regular dental examinations.

A tooth that has become badly infected can be removed with safety during this period. Extraction of teeth will not cause a miscarriage or harm the baby.
